




Please read these instructions carefully prior to installation.

Please refer to your fitting instruction to ensure that the roof racks are installed in the correct locations. Check the contents of kit before commencing fitment and report any discrepancies.

Place these instructions in the vehicle's glove box after installation is complete.

Note: Be sure to check the Rhino-Rack website to see if you have the latest version of instructions before beginning installation.

Maximum permissible load is 100kg (220lbs) for two crossbars including the weight of the crossbars, 5kg (11lbs). When crossbars are to be used in off-road conditions, please build a safety factor of 1.5 into this load limit for off-road use, two crossbars = 66kg 145lbs). Although the crossbars are tested and approved to AS1235-2000, off-road conditions can be much more rigorous. However, increasing the number of crossbars does not increase the vehicles maximum permissible roof loading.

Refer to vehicle manufacturers handbook for maximum roof loading. Always use lower of the two figures.

Recommendations:

It is essential that all bolt connections be checked after driving a short distance when you first install your crossbars. Bolt connections should be checked again at regular intervals (probably once a week is enough, depending on road conditions, usage, loads and distances travelled). You should also check the crossbars each time they are refitted. Make sure to fasten your load securely. Please ensure that all loads are evenly distributed and that the centre of gravity is kept as low as possible.

Crossbars must be removed when putting vehicle through an automatic car wash.

Carrying Loads: Use only non-stretch fastening ropes or straps to secure your load.

Caution: The handling characteristics of the vehicle change when you transport a load on the roof. For safety reasons we recommend you exercise extreme care when transporting wind-resistant loads. Special consideration must be taken into account when cornering and braking.

























Ensure Ladder is well supported on the ground to help support tent. Take extreme caution when climbing heights above 1.2m/4ft.







Crossbar System.



When these roof racks are to be used on a vehicle that is driven off sealed roads, the maximum roof rack load rating should be *divided* by 1.5. Do not forget to subtract 5kg from your maximum carrying capacity due to the weight of the crossbars and legs.




100kg/220lbs load rating (Urban road) 66kg/145lbs load rating (Off road - 100kg / 1.5)




WARNING! Important Load Carrying Instructions

With utility vehicles, the cabin and the canopy move independently. Roofracks and vehicle can be damaged if the item transported is rigidly fixed at points on both the cabin and canopy. Instead, rigidly fix to either the cabin roofracks or the canopy roofracks.









Tools required: Allen key, included. 10mm socket wrench.

VW Amarok with Ditch Fill

For models with ditch fill, locate the 4x M6 Mounting Point Caps, these will be covered with a plastic covers. Use a flat head screwdriver and unscrew the covers to remove them. This will expose the Mounting Point Caps below.










VW Amarok with no Ditch Fill


Move to the roof of the vehicle. 1: If your car is not fitted with ditch trim, locate the 4x M6 Mounting Point Caps in the roof ditch. 2: Unscrew the 4x M6 Mounting Point Caps with a 5mm allen key. Clean roof ditch with a cloth.













Assembly for Models with no **Ditch Trim:**

Left skirt - Left M552 Right skirt - Right M553






Assembly for Models with Ditch Trim:

Left skirt - Left M550 Right skirt - Right M551



Fit Trim Covers, 4 places. Only for vehicles with Ditch Trim.







Install the hardware supplied into each Base assembly. Note: The Base Assemblies for vehicles with Ditch Fills are completed in the same fashion.




Sit the Assemblies into place.

Support rubber skirt when fitting to prevent it from folding under.















Attach to Vehicles with Ditch Trim.

Fasten pads to roof.


Tighten M6 x 30mm screws, 5-6 Nm (3-4 lb/ft).

Tighten M6 x 30mm screws, 5-6 Nm (3-4 lb/ft).



When crossbars are not in use, install the cover plates over the mounting points.
